The R.S.U. No. 67 Board of Directors encourages teachers to provide such instruction and influence in accordance with state law as follows:

“Instructors of youth in public or private institutions, shall use their best endeavors to impress on the minds of the children and youth committed to their care and instruction the principals of morality and justice and a sacred regard for the great principals of humanity as illustrated by kindness to birds and animals and regard for all factors which contribute to the well-being of man; industry and frugality; chastity, moderation and temperance; and all other virtues which ornament human society; and to lead those under their care, as their ages and capacities admit, into a particular understanding of the tendency of such virtue to preserve and perfect a republican constitution, secure the blessings of liberty and to promote their future happiness.”
